NOTE: Please leave personal possessions at home, such as purses, umbrellas or coats. We have no secure place to store items.

We at People to People Ministries are busy preparing for our annual **Back to School Project**, which takes place this year August 4th -9th at the Wooster Church of the Nazarene. Our Back to School effort is truly a special project. It is our goal to provide children of families in need with new underwear, new socks, a voucher for new shoes, school supplies, and "nice as new" clothing. Last year, we outfitted 812 children for school!

A project this large requires hundreds of volunteers, and we're going to need your help! Women, men, and college-age students will be given full training to assist the children one-on-one in making clothing selections. High school youth groups are needed and encouraged to help us with loading and unloading, set up, moving boxes, and clean up at the end of the week.

You might also consider collecting school supplies for the project. We are always grateful for any school supplies donated to us. This year we are going to try something a little different for those individuals that do not know what supplies to collect. We are asking for you to "Sponsor a child" for \$15.00 per child this will cover their back pack and basic school supplies. You can donate by check, Paypal, or cash but make sure it is labeled as "BTS Sponsor a child".

If you have any questions, please call me at (330) 262-1662. Messages may be left 24 hours a day - I'll get back to you as soon as possible. Thank you for your special assistance. Together we can help Wayne County children, who need us, get back to school feeling and looking good!

Here are several ways that you can help:

- 1. Phone Calls:** making phone calls to schedule volunteers (July 11 - July 27)
- 2. Load / Unload:** loading boxes onto or off a truck.
- 3. Set-up:** unpacking boxes and organizing clothing on tables at the church.
- 4. DISTRIBUTION:** assisting one child at a time (3-4 children per shift) in choosing their school clothing; complete training is provided during the first ½ hour of each Distribution shift.
- 5. Restock & straighten:** reorganizing clothing tables during distribution shifts and assisting shoppers.
- 6. Clean - up:** re-packing leftover clothing; returning boxes, racks & supplies, etc. to the office.

Men & women (over 18) are needed to help shop & select clothing with the children.

Do you have a friend that would like to help? *We need extra people to restock and straighten.*

We welcome men to help the children choose their clothing. Boys need those good role models!

If you volunteer, please remember to leave your personal possessions at home.

Do you have a teenager interested in volunteering? Because we feel we must protect the identity of the children we are assisting, current junior high and high school students may NOT help with distribution. We always welcome *youth & youth groups* to load and unload trucks on moving days!

Not a good year for you? Send in your form in to let us know. That way we won't bother you with a phone call. Our volunteer callers will begin making phone calls July 13.
