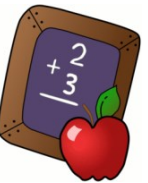

Last year, we tried something new, asking you to "Sponsor a Child for \$15" for school supplies. With the help of so many caring individuals we raised close to \$9,000.00 dollars for just school supplies. At the end of the project we had our final expenses calculated for school supplies only. Our final school supplies purchased came to \$16,318.78 which divided by the 535 children we had, our total school supplies came to \$30.51 per child. That is not including our purchases of the new socks and underwear, new shoes from Payless, or new bras for teen girls from Kohl's. This is our most expensive project we get to do for the children of Wayne County, so we are once again asking for you to "Sponsor a Child" but please make your donation for what you can afford. BACK TO SCHOOL 2019

August 3 - 8

Each August People To People Ministries reaches out to eligible Wayne County school children by assisting families with school clothing and supplies. Gently used clothing, new shoes, new underwear, new socks, and new school supplies are provided with the understanding that when kids look good, they feel good about themselves.

The project this year will be held at the Wayne County Schools Career Center 518 W Prospect St, Smithville, OH 44677

Please volunteer a few hours of your time. We need you!

Here are several ways that you can help:

Phone Calls: making phone calls to schedule volunteers (Monday July 15 - July 30th)

Load / Unload: loading boxes onto or off a truck.

Set-up: unpacking boxes and organizing clothing on tables at the WCSCC.

Distribution: assisting one child at a time (3 - 4 children per shift) in choosing their school clothing; complete training is provided during the first 1/2 hour of each Distribution shift.

Restock & straighten reorganizing clothing tables during distribution shifts and assisting shoppers.

Clean - up: re-packing leftover clothing; returning boxes, racks & supplies, etc. to the office.

Men & women (over 18) are needed to help shop & select clothing with the children

Do you have a friend that would like to help? We need extra people to restock and straighten. We welcome men to help the children choose their clothing. Boys need those good role models! If you volunteer, please remember to leave your personal possessions at home.

Do you have a teenager interested in volunteering?

We always welcome youth & youth groups to load and unload trucks on moving days!

Because we feel we must protect the identity of the children we are assisting, current junior high and high school students may NOT help with distribution.

Not a good year for you?

Send your form in to let us know. That way we won't bother you with a phone call. Our volunteer callers will begin making phone calls July 15.
