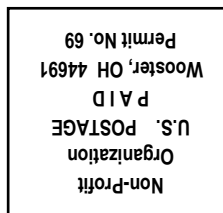

It is hard to believe it is that time of year again! But here we are and with so many changes and challenges to face in 2020 with Covid-19. Who would have thought we all would be living through a pandemic? I know we are all just trying to figure this all out. What a different world. Please know we are praying for everyone and for our country.

So here we are trying to figure out our plans for our "Back to School Project." We have spoken to several school districts and their plans are not certain whether school will be full-time, virtual, part-time, or both. Regardless as to how they end up attending school, the schools all agreed that the students will still need school supplies. So, we have decided to move forward with our Back to School Project with Covid-19 in mind and safety our first priority. After several changes and new procedures in place, we are asking you once again to "Sponsor a Child for \$35" for Back to School.

Please keep in mind, this is our most expensive project that we provide for the children of Wayne County. So yes we are once again asking for you to "Sponsor a Child for \$35.00" but please make your donations for what you can afford.

Last year, with the help of so many caring individuals we raised \$6,502.55 just for school supplies. At the end of the project last year, we calculated our expenses just for the school supplies and the total expense came to \$15,917.93 which when divided by the 510 children we had last year, came to \$31.21 per child. That is not including our purchases of the "new" socks and underwear, "new" shoes from The Shoe Dept., or the "new bras" for teen girls from Kohl's. If you are able to sponsor a child for the rounded up total amount of \$35.00, that should cover the cost of an individual child's school supplies. However, we greatly appreciate any amount. So, if you can only make a \$10.00 donation that is also great! Any denomination is a true Blessing not only to the children of Wayne County but also to People To People Ministries and allows us to continue with this huge project every year. Thank you for all you do for our Wayne County community.

Back to School - Covid-19

Information on how we will proceed safely with this years project with Covid-19 procedures in place.

This year our project will be held July 20th through August 5th at the First Presbyterian Church next to People to People and the hours will be 12pm - 8pm daily for client shopping. In past years we needed hundreds of volunteers to make this event happen. Unfortunately, we will not be needing as many volunteers this year. We will only be having 3 families shop every hour and will not be having the children shop this year with a volunteer due to Covid-19 and social distancing. We will possibly need a 100 over the whole month period. We will be needing around 10-20 volunteers daily to help with set up, tear down, and during the project. The dates for set up will be July 11th through July 18th with no Sundays. Then clean up and tear down will be on August 6th (and the 7th if necessary).

If you are interested in helping volunteer for this year's project, you can sign up on-line on our website at www.ptpm.net by clicking on the "Special Projects Tab" and selecting the "Back to School Tab." From there, you will scroll to the bottom of the page and click on the Volunteer Sign Up Link. We will contact you by email to schedule your volunteer dates and times.

Please keep in mind we will be requiring all volunteers, staff, and clients to wear masks and gloves. We will have a wellness check station set up soon as entering the church.

We are asking everyone to wear a mask before entering, then you will have your temperature taken. We will ask you to sanitize your hands, and provide you with a pair of gloves. We also ask that you leave your gloves and mask on at all times while inside the church. If you would need to use the restroom or leave the building and return, we ask that you wash/sanitize your hands and please retrieve a new pair of gloves.

Thank you for helping us during these uncertain times. Together, safely we can and will make a difference.

Registration Set Up- Bruch Hall – Friday June 26th

Registration - Bruch Hall- June 29th – July 10th

- In-person registration for "NEW" clients, past clients prior to 2018, and clients without a phone only.
- Current 2018/2019 clients that do not have internet access will also be able to register by phone.
- We will have registration set up for current 2018/2019 clients to complete online registration. This will help limit the number of in-person registrations.

Project Set up – Bruch Hall – Saturday July 11th – Saturday July 18th (No Sundays)

- Saturday July 11th we would like to start setting up for the project.
- We would like to take this whole week to set up if needed.
- We will need 10 volunteers to help us transport inventory to church from PTPM and another location to be announced. We will give the details once you are signed up to help. We are only wanting to have 10 outside volunteers at any given time daily.

Project Appointment Dates - Bruch Hall - Monday July 20th - August 5th (No Saturdays or Sundays)

- We will need volunteers to disinfect and wipe down high touch areas daily.
- We will have appointments from Noon - 8 pm Monday through Friday.
- We would schedule families to shop separately every 15 mins through out the day.
- Each family will stay together and separate from other family's by social distancing with a 15 min gap before the next family will be able to enter the building. (max of 3 families shopping)
- There will be markings of arrows with gaffers tape on the floor and signage directing the shopping direction/path. There will also be volunteer guidance to keep clients moving.
- This will allow us to make appointments for up to 24 families a day and up to 312 families over the 13-day time period.
- The families will be asked to wait in their cars until their appointment time. We will need a volunteer to help with signaling the family to come in.
- There will be one-way entrance and exit. Come in the church side glass entrance and exit the side door in kitchen.

Project Clean up – Bruch Hall – Thursday August 6th - 7th (If needed)

- Tear down and clean up. 8am – 5pm over two days if needed.
- We are hopeful to have enough volunteers that we will not need all two days.



There are several ways you can help.....
